CHOREOGRAPHER'S SHOWCASE 2016 GUIDELINES

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRY FORMS: May 7, 2016

- 1. The Choreographer's Showcase is open to students ages 12-19. Professional choreographers are not eligible.
- 2. The choreography may be to music of your choice.
- 3. The choreography may be for a minimum of one to a maximum of ten dancers.
- 4. The maximum length for the completed choreographic work is 10 minutes.
- 5. The choreography must be performed live.
- 6. Costumes are at the discretion of the choreographer. Sets and props must be kept to a minimum. Our primary focus is on the choreography and not the production.
- 7. All choreographer entrants will receive constructive feedback from our adjudicators after the performances, be encouraged to continue their development as a creative artist in choreography, and will see their works presented before an audience.
- 8. Choreographers will present their choreography in a public performance on Saturday, May 14th at the Columbia Dance Center, 1700 Broadway; Vancouver, WA at 6:00pm. The ticket cost for audience members is \$5.00. Staging rehearsals will be scheduled. A panel of dance professionals will adjudicate.
- 9. Our adjudicators' decisions are final.
- 10. Our adjudicators will be available for private conferences with choreographers after the awards presentation.
- 11. ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 PER CHOREOGRAPHIC WORK

Choreographer's Tool Box

Concepts the adjudicator may look for:

- 1. Choice of appropriate music (vocals present a specific challenge)
- 2. Does the choreography have a clear beginning middle end?
- 3. Is the relationship of your dancers in the choreography clear?
- 4. If the choreographer chooses to use a prop, is it explored and used correctly?
- 5. Use of space/use of different directions in space.
- 6. Use of levels
- 7. Patterns and repetitions
- 8. Use of musicality
- 9. Canon
- 10. Stylistic consistency
- 11. Unison and non-unison movement
- 12. Creativity in movement choices (vs. classroom steps)
- 13. Appropriate length of choreography
