## ENRICHING LIVES THROUGH DANCE

27 Children with disabilities who benefit from our free, accessible dance classes.

- Students at ORCHARDS ELEMENTARY
  SCHOOL participate in our free enrichment classes.
- 210 Students ages 3-18 train weekly at our state-of-the-art 4 studio facility

1,500 Vancouver Public School 3rd graders who study our Nutcracker curriculum and attend a live performance annually

- Learn persistence, discipline, teamwork & goal setting
- Are significantly more motivated academically, especially students from low socio-economic groups
- Perform community service more than 4 times more often than their non-artist peers.

#### 2024 OUTREACH HIGHLIGHT-ORCHARDS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Columbia Dance now provides weekly dance classes at Orchards Elementary School, a title 1 school with 93% lowincome families. We have **100 elementary students dance with us at Orchards each week!** 

Their administrator wrote "The reality, for a majority of our families is that they aren't able to enroll their children in extracurricular activities. I had one parent call me up in tears because they were so appreciative that their kid was getting to take a dance class. The mom reported that her child said, 'Mama, I get to learn to dance just like the other kids!' This particular family is in a homeless situation and working extremely hard to get back on their feet."

\$100	<b>FUNDS 1 WEEK OF INCLUDE CLASSES</b> Accessible dance classes for children with disabilities that Columbia Dance offers tuition-free.
\$200	SUBSIDIZES 1 COMPANY DANCER'S TRIP TO THE BALLET ALLIANCE FESTIVAL- An experience where they are exposed to world class teachers and considered for acceptance into college dance programs and summer training scholarships.

\$3,000	<b>SEND A FACULTY MEMBER TO TEACHER TRAINING</b> We are only as good as our teachers. Professional Development is key to maintaining our high standards of instruction.
\$4,000	<b>1 YEAR OF FINANCIAL AID FOR ADVANCED STUDENT</b> These teenagers devote 15 hours per week to their dance studies.
\$5,000	<b>FUND OUR ORCHARDS ELEMENTARY OUTREACH PROGRAM</b> This would cover 1 year of costs to bring dance to 100 students at a title 1 elementary school for an entire school year.
\$7,000	<b>SPONSOR SERENADE</b> Columbia Dance's first ever Balanchine ballet needs a sponsor to cover the costs of our guest repetiteur, licensing fees, costume rentals, and theater upgrades.
